But **we must follow Jesus** (Luke 23:34).

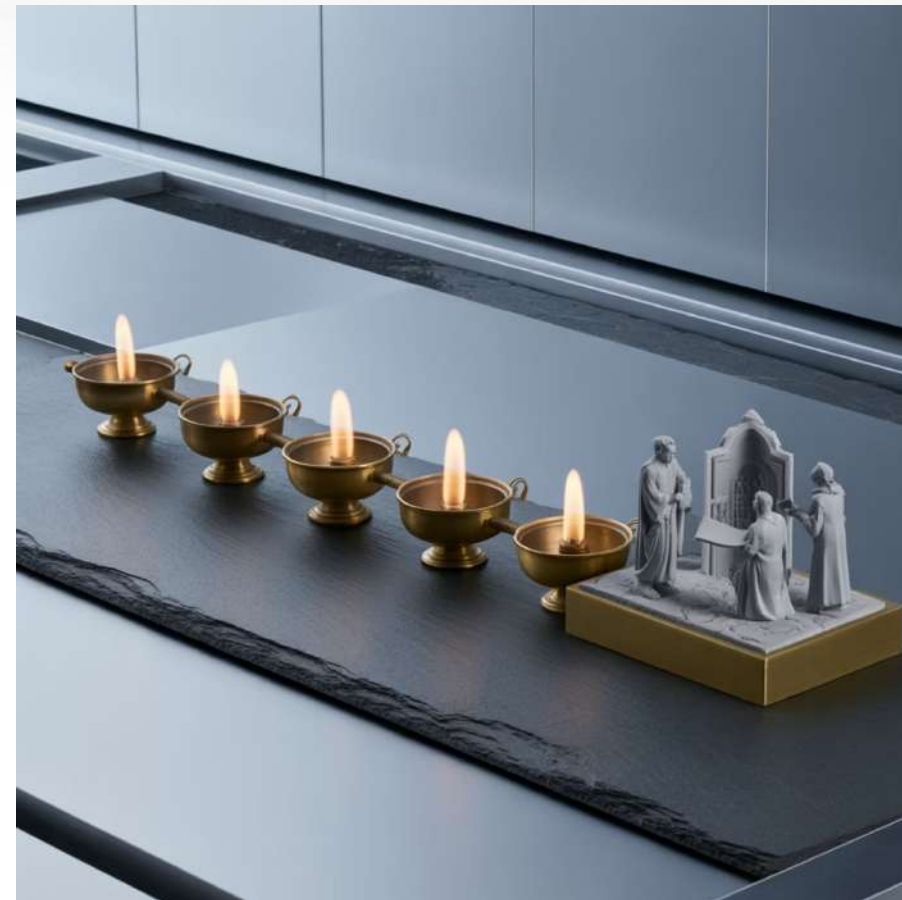

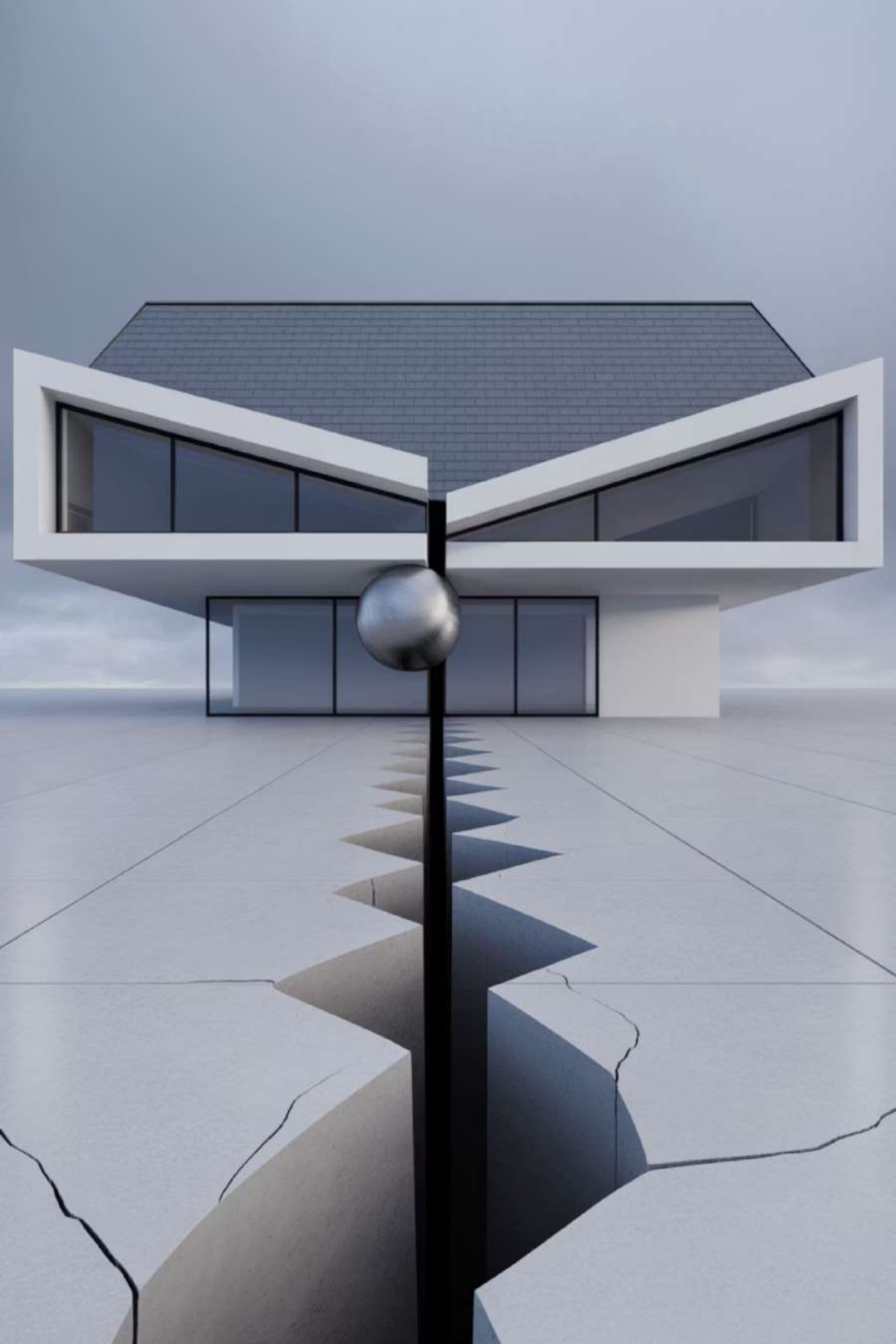
Enemy seeks to divide

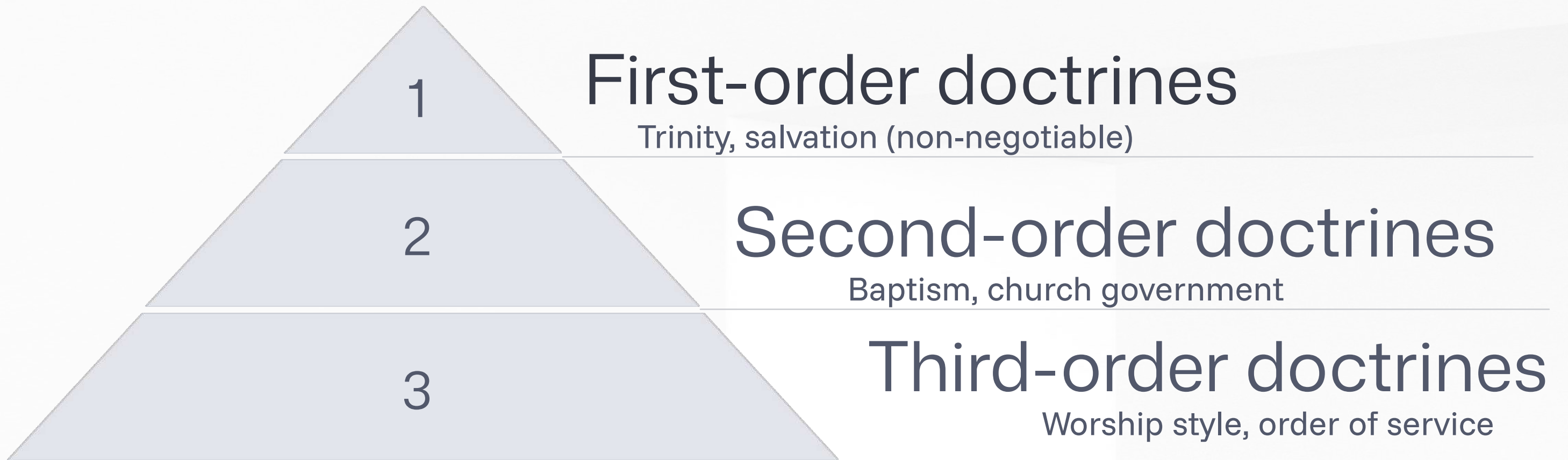

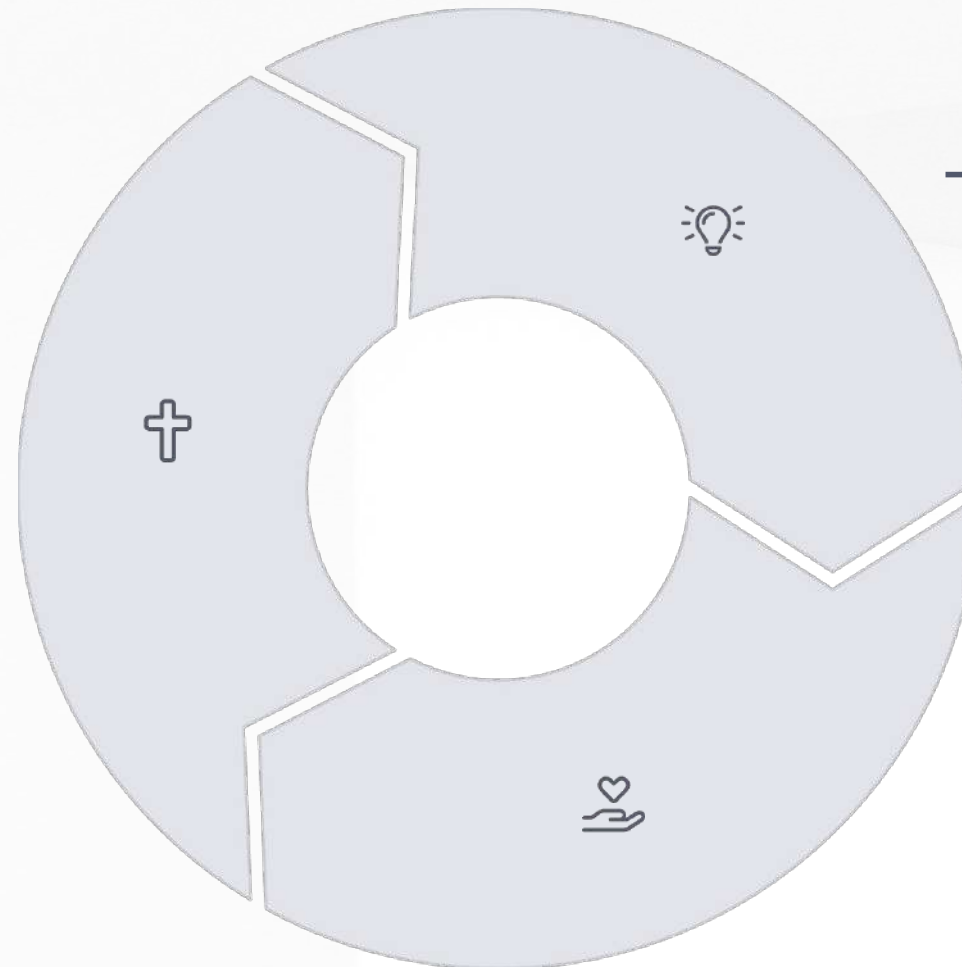
